

WILL PROVISIONS

In response to requests received on making Will provisions to Hampden-Sydney, there are several possible options: a bequest to the College for a fixed percentage of the estate or one can specify that all or a certain percentage of the residuary portion of the estate be designated to the College.

Samples of suitable language are as follows:

A Bequest of a Fixed Percentage

“I give and bequeath _____ percent (___%) of my estate to The PRESIDENT AND TRUSTEES OF HAMPDEN-SYDNEY COLLEGE, a Virginia non-stock educational corporation located at Hampden-Sydney, Virginia, to be used for such general purposes of the College as the Trustees thereof may deem appropriate.”

Residuary of Estate

“I give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate to the PRESIDENT AND TRUSTEES OF HAMPDEN-SYDNEY COLLEGE, a Virginia non-stock educational corporation located at Hampden-Sydney, Virginia, to be used for such general purposes of the College as the Trustees thereof many deem appropriate.”

Residuary (Percentage of Estate)

“All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, I give, devise and bequeath to the following beneficiaries: _____ (%___) of the said residue and remainder to the PRESIDENT AND TRUSTEES OF HAMPDEN-SYDNEY COLLEGE, a Virginia non-stock educational corporation located at Hampden-Sydney, Virginia, to be used for such general purposes of the College as the Trustees thereof may deem appropriate.”

If you already have a Will, you need not execute a new one to make a provision for Hampden-Sydney. Rather, you can contact your attorney and have a codicil drawn up to amend your Will to include a bequest. If you would like to restrict your bequest for a specific program or project, please state that in the bequest provision.
